

Flags and Custom Fields


Depending on their purpose, Flags and Custom Fields in DonorPerfect will be mapped to either Tags or Custom Fields in CRM+.



Campaign Record



Code Creation



Often times DP Codes do not map one-to-one. To create the Segment Code in CRM+, we typically concatenate the codes from Donor Perfect Campaign, Solicitation, and Subsolicitation.

Sub **Solicitations**



Because the use of Sub Solicitations in Donor Perfect is less common, they are not often included in the default mapping. If your data includes Sub Solicitations, these will likely map to Segments.
